

They contain armorial bearings; alternately the imperial eagle displayed, and a demi eagle impaled with two bends, being the arms of the city of Niirnburg (?). The chasse is placed on an altar tomb, the ends and sides of which are recessed in panels filled with sculptured basreliefs and the four angles supported by detached pillars; it stands on a base. The whole is enclosed in a shrine or chapel, with a roof elaborately ornamented with architectural groinings, and surmounted by three richly composed canopies, which rise with great multiplication of parts, such as niches, arches, c. The centre canopy is surmounted by an image of the Infant Saviour holding an orb in His left hand. The roof is supported on three side and two end arches,...
